## Harbour (Amendment) Regulations 1977

## **CUSTOMS ORDINANCE**

(Chapter 16)

## Customs (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1977

No. 4 of 1977.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 230 of the Customs Ordinance, the Governor in Council has made the following regulations —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1977 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October 1977.

Citation and commencement.

2. The Customs (Fees) Regulations 1975 are amended by Addition of regulation 4a. adding, after regulation 4, the following regulation—

"Entering or clearing at any place other than at declared port, the fee shall be £100 plus the full cost of the return fare of the Customs Officer.".
