CUSTOMS ORDINANCE (Chapter 16)

Customs (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1978

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 230 of the Customs Ordinance the Governor in Council has made the following regulations —

Citation and commencement. 1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October 1978.

Amendment of regulation 3. (2 of 1975)

2. Paragraph (d) of regulation 3 of the Customs (Fees) Regulations 1975 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations) is amended by inserting before "Sundays" the following — "Saturdays,".

Amendment of regulation

3. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting "ten pounds" and substituting the following —
"twenty pounds".

Addition of regulation 4s.

4. The principal regulations are amended by adding, after regulation 4 $\rm A$, the following regulation —

"Entering and clearing vessels under 15 tons.

4B. The fee payable for entering or clearing a vessel under 15 tons shall be half of the fee payable under regulation 4 or 4A above.".
