Notice of His Excellency the Governor in Council declaring The Wrecks Ordinance, 1899, The Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1909, and The Whale Fishery Amendment Ordinance, 1912, to be in force in the Dependencies.

In pursuance of the powers in him vested by section 3 of the Dependencies Ordinance, 1908, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby declares the Wrecks Ordinance, No. 111 of 1899, the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, No. IX of 1909, and the Whale Fishery Amendment Ordinance, No. V of 1912, to be in force in the Dependencies, so far as circumstances permit and local conditions render necessary.
