Waterlow & Sons, Limited, London Wall, London, 1915, which Edition shall be deemed to be and shall be without any question whatsoever in all Courts of Justice and for all other purposes whatsoever the sole and only proper Ordinance Book of the Colony up to the date of the latest of the Ordinances contained therein, as provided by The New Edition of the Ordinances Ordinance, 1911.
