3. Any proclamation made by the Governor under the said section as so amended may, whilst a state of war exists, be varied or added to from time to time by proclamation by the Governor.

## Whale Oil (Export) Regulation.

Dated the 3rd December, 1915.

Under the provisions of The Whale Oil (Export Regulation) Ordinance, 1915, the export of whale oil from the Colony of the Falkland Islands or its Dependencies is hereby prohibited to any destination other than a Port in the United Kingdom, without a written export licence first obtained from the Collector of Customs or his Deputy.
