ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of the Falkland Enacting Clause. Islands, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows -

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Income Tax (Amend- Short title. ment) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be read and construed as one with the Income Tax Ordinance, 1939, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance) and all amendments thereto, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January, 1951.
- 2. In section 15 of the Principal Ordinance for the word Amendment of "eighty" there shall be substituted the words "one hundred".
- 3. In subsection (1) of section 21 of the Principal Ordinance Amendment of for the figures "1/6" there shall be substituted the figure "1/-".
