### An Ordinance

To repeal the Merchandise Marks Ordinance. Title.

[1st April, 1953]

Date of commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of the Falkland Islands, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Enacting clause.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Merchandise Marks (Repeal) Ordinance, 1953. Short title.
2. The Merchandise Marks Ordinance is hereby repealed. Repeal.
