FISHERIES (TRANSHIPMENT LICENCE FEES) (VALIDATION) ORDINANCE 2022

AN ORDINANCE

To validate transhipment licence fees collected without legislative authority.

ENACTED by the Commissioner for South Georgia and South Sandwich Islands -

1. Title

This Ordinance is the Fisheries (Transhipment Licence Fees) (Validation) Ordinance 2022.

2. Commencement

This Ordinance comes into force on publication in the Gazette.

3. Interpretation

In this Ordinance —

"**transhipment licence**" has the same meaning as given in section 2 of the Fisheries (Conservation and Management) Ordinance 2000.

4. Validation of transhipment licence fees

Any fee for a transhipment licence demanded or collected on or after 1 May 2020 until the date of commencement of the Fisheries (Transhipment and Export) (Amendment) Order 2022 is validated as if the fee had been provided for in the Schedule to the Fisheries (Transhipment and Export) Regulations 1990.

EXPLANATORY NOTE (not part of the Ordinance)

This Ordinance validates transhipment licence fees that were demanded and collected without legislative authority. The fees collected between 1 May 2020 and the date of commencement of the Fisheries (Transhipment and Export) (Amendment) Order 2022 were collected without the necessary legal process of amending the Schedule to the Fisheries (Transhipment and Export) Regulations 1990. To regularise the situation, an amendment to the transhipment fee will be made by the Fisheries (Transhipment and Export) (Amendment) Order 2022.
