South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands Order 1985, section 7; and Administration of Justice Ordinance 1949, section 29

Appointment of Acting Attorney General and Acting Coroner

1. In exercise of my powers under section 7 of the South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands Order 1985, I appoint **Momtaz Begum** to be Acting Attorney General for the purpose of carrying out the duties of the Attorney General at any time when the post is vacant, or the substantive holder of the post, Simon David Young, is unavailable to discharge the same through any absence from the Falkland Islands or inability to perform the functions and duties of the post.

2. In exercise of my powers under section 29 of the Administration of Justice Ordinance 1949 in its application to South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands, I appoint **Momtaz Begum** to be Acting Coroner for the purpose of carrying out the duties of the Coroner at any time when the post is vacant, or the substantive holder of the post is unavailable to discharge the same through any absence from the Falkland Islands or inability to perform the functions and duties of the post.

3. These appointments have effect from 7 October 2025, and continue in effect whilst Momtaz Begum holds office as the Head of Legal Services of the Falkland Islands Government, unless terminated sooner.
